

CUB SCOUTS PACK 88 BY-LAWS 2023-2024

Our mission is to prepare scouts to make moral and ethical choices throughout their lifetime by instilling in them the values of the Scout Oath and Law.
“Doing a Good Turn Daily” in the home, the pack & the community.

Cub scouting is a joint partnership between a dedicated adult partner and their child. Your participation with different aspects of Scouting will be required, whether a donation of time, skills or items.
An **active** adult, leads to an **enthusiastic** child!!

- 1) Yearly **registration fee: New Scouts \$210/year. Returning Scouts \$195/year.** This amount goes to council to pay for Charter fees and registration for scouts, adult leaders and committee members.
- 2) Dues of **\$10 will be collected monthly** by den leaders for use for den needs.
- 3) All leaders, committee members, and adult partners of every scout **must be Youth Protection** trained before participating with the scouts. Leaders must be Cub Specific Trained by council or online by 11/13/2023. Weather Hazards training required before ANY Den trip.

- 4) Fundraising is needed to cover the cost of advancements, patches, and Pack Events. We will have a mandatory **Applebee's Breakfast With Santa Fundraiser on Saturday 12/16/2023** from 8 to 10am. Each scout is required to sell at least 10 tickets at \$10 per ticket, and we need scouts with their adult partner to volunteer. Scouts who do not participate in this mandatory fundraiser will not receive advancements or patches, and may not be able to participate in certain Pack events.
- 5) Uniforms: **Full Class 'A' must be worn to all Pack Nights, ceremonies, and formal outings** unless told differently. Webelos/AOL - tan Scout shirt and olive green pants/shorts. All other ranks - blue Scout shirt & blue pants/shorts/jeans. No athleticwear. All patches must be sewn on in the correct places. Red vests are optional for extra activity patches (AKA Fun Patches).
- 6) We are all here to provide a positive and supportive scouting experience. Behavior not aligned with Cub Scouting will not be permitted. Pack 88 reserves the right to terminate membership without refund if a violation is determined. If you see something, please say something to your leaders.
- 7) All deadlines must be adhered to and all money will be collected by Den Leaders or a designated Committee Member.
